

This guide covers basic sources of legal information for New York State case law (decisions of judges), statutory law (acts of the legislature) and administrative law (rules and regulations). For questions on United States court cases, see the library guide [How to Find Court Cases](#). For questions of U.S. laws and regulations, see the library guide [United States Laws and Regulations](#). For questions on tax law, see the guide [Taxation Sources](#). ### A NOTE ON COURT CASE CITATIONS

Common practice is to list plaintiff first, then defendant. There are cross-references in most indexes to defendants. Legal citations follow the form 123 ABC 456 (e.g., 339 N.Y.S.2d 113). The first group of numbers is a volume number; the letters in the middle designate the publication in question; and last group is the page number. Many times, several sources for the case are given—you can find the case in any of the sources listed. Use the abbreviation in the citation to find the name of the source. In this guide, the abbreviation for a legal series is listed in the left margin. For an exhaustive list see ***Bieber's Dictionary of Legal Abbreviations***, Ref KF246 .B46.
